



Construction Update: Oct. 15-21, 2018

*NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting and is subject to change without notice. Regular construction hours are **Monday-Saturday 7 a.m.-5 p.m.** although crews may work Sundays and/or evenings if needed.*

Northbound I-25 – Traffic remains shifted to the right lane and shoulder through most of the construction zone; northbound I-25 is reduced to two lanes just south of the I-25 northbound on-ramp. The I-25 northbound off-ramp is **closed** at Rio Bravo through spring 2019. Broadway is the detour (see map).

Southbound I-25 – Traffic has been shifted to new permanent lanes just west of the existing northbound lanes and north of the Rio Bravo interchange. The I-25 southbound on-ramp is **closed** at Rio Bravo through fall 2018. Broadway is the detour (see map).

Eastbound Rio Bravo – Has a dedicated left turn lane for eastbound traffic to turn north on Broadway.

Westbound Rio Bravo – Has a dedicated left turn lane for westbound traffic to turn south on Broadway.

NIGHTTIME CLOSURES THIS WEEK:

On **Monday, Oct. 15** from **8 p.m.-5 a.m.**, eastbound Rio Bravo will have the right lane closed under the I-25 Bridge.

On **Tuesday, Oct. 16** & **Wednesday, Oct. 17** from **9 p.m.-5 a.m.** eastbound Rio Bravo will have the left lane closed and westbound Rio Bravo will be closed at I-25.

TENTATIVE WORK THIS COMING WEEKEND: From **7 a.m.-12 p.m. noon** on **Saturday, Oct. 20** (weather permitting) the southbound I-25 off-ramp will be **closed**. Motorists will be able to exit southbound I-25 at Gibson or Broadway.

From **7 a.m.-5 p.m. Sunday, Oct. 21** (weather permitting), southbound I-25 will have alternating lane closures. Motorists traveling in this area should use extra caution during this work.

NOTE: There are traffic restrictions and lane reductions on northbound and southbound Broadway near the Rio Bravo intersection. Also, there is no access to Electric Avenue from southbound Broadway.

SPEED LIMITS ARE REDUCED IN THE CONSTRUCTION ZONE.

NOTE: The multi-use path is closed about 400 feet west of the intersection of Broadway and Rio Bravo for safety for the duration of the project.

Motorists should expect delays, particularly during morning and afternoon commutes or nighttime work, obey reduced speeds in the construction zone and watch for construction signs.
