



## **Construction Update: May 14-20, 2018**

*NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting and is subject to change without notice.*

Regular construction hours are **Monday-Saturday 7 a.m.-5 p.m.** although crews may work Sundays and/or evenings if needed.

**Northbound I-25** – Traffic remains shifted to the right lane and shoulder through most of the construction zone; northbound I-25 is reduced to two lanes just north of the I-25 northbound on-ramp

**Southbound I-25** – As of Friday, May 18, southbound I-25 traffic will shift to new lanes located west of the current lanes south of the Rio Bravo interchange. Motorists should use extra caution in this area, particularly during the first few days.

**Eastbound Rio Bravo** – Is on new lanes between Prince and I-25. There is a dedicated left turn lane for eastbound traffic to turn north on Broadway.

**Westbound Rio Bravo** – Is on new lanes between Prince and I-25. There is a dedicated left turn lane for westbound traffic to turn south on Broadway.

**IMPORTANT TRAFFIC SHIFT AND DETOUR BEGINNING FRIDAY, MAY 18:** Beginning **Friday morning, May 18**, southbound I-25 traffic will be shifted to new lanes south of the Rio Bravo interchange. Also, the **I-25 southbound on-ramp will be closed** at Rio Bravo through fall 2018, and the **I-25 northbound off-ramp will be closed** at Rio Bravo through spring 2019. Broadway Blvd. will be the detour (see map to right).

**NIGHT WORK:** Night work is tentatively scheduled on **Southbound I-25** at the Rio Bravo interchange this week to prepare for the traffic switch. **Various lanes may be closed from 8 p.m.-5 a.m. as needed.**

**NOTE:** *There are also traffic restrictions and lane reductions on northbound and southbound Broadway near the Rio Bravo intersection.*

**Electric Avenue** – There is no access to Electric Avenue from southbound Broadway

### **SPEED LIMITS ARE REDUCED IN THE CONSTRUCTION ZONE.**

**NOTE:** The multi-use path is closed about 400 feet west of the intersection of Broadway and Rio Bravo for safety for the duration of the project.

***Motorists should expect delays, particularly during morning and afternoon commutes or nighttime work, obey reduced speeds in the construction zone and watch for construction signs.***
