Construction Update: Week of Sept. 4-10, 2017

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting and is subject to change without notice.

Regular construction hours are **Monday-Sunday 7 a.m.-5 p.m.** although crews may work evenings if needed. **NOTE: Crews may not work Mon., Sept. 4 in observance of Labor Day but barricades will remain in place for safety.**

Rio Bravo from University to I-25 – Is restricted to one lane in each direction (eastbound and westbound). Motorists can enter and exit I-25 at Rio Bravo.

Rio Bravo from I-25 to Broadway – Is restricted to two lanes in each direction (eastbound and westbound). Motorists can turn southbound and northbound onto Broadway from Rio Bravo.

Rio Bravo at South Diversion Channel Bridge – Is restricted to one lane in each direction (eastbound and westbound).

Broadway Blvd. – Is restricted to one through lane in each direction (northbound and southbound) north and south of Rio Bravo and there is also work on the shoulders. Motorists can turn eastbound and westbound on Rio Bravo, however both northbound and southbound traffic in the left lane **MUST** turn left at the intersection of Broadway and Rio Bravo.

Electric Avenue – There is no access to Electric Avenue from southbound Broadway.

NIGHT WORK: from 9 p.m. each evening to 5 a.m. the next morning on I-25:

Northbound I-25 from about 4,000 feet south of the I-25/Rio Bravo Interchange to the Interchange – Will be reduced to one lane on the right-hand side closest to the shoulder during the first part of the week, starting on Tuesday, Sept. 5.

Southbound I-25 from the I-25/Rio Bravo Interchange to about 4,000 feet south of the Interchange – Will be reduced to one lane on the right-hand side closest to the shoulder in the latter of the part of the week.

All on-ramps and off-ramps in the area will remain open.

NOTE: The multi-use path is closed about 400 feet west of the intersection of Broadway and Rio Bravo for safety for the duration of the project.

Motorists should expect delays, particularly during morning and afternoon commutes or nighttime work.
