



Night Work Planned on I-25/Rio Bravo Interchange Project Sept. 5-8, 2017

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting and is subject to change without notice.

AUI will be working nights, from **9 p.m. each evening to 5 a.m. the next morning**, on I-25 to mill and install asphalt to prepare for the upcoming traffic switch to Phase I.

Northbound I-25 from about 4,000 feet south of the I-25/Rio Bravo Interchange to the Interchange – Will be **reduced to one lane** on the righthand side closest to the shoulder during the first part of the week, starting on **Tuesday, Sept. 5.**

Southbound I-25 from the I-25/Rio Bravo Interchange to about 4,000 feet south of the Interchange – Will be **reduced to one lane** on the righthand side closest to the shoulder in the latter of the part of the week.

All on-ramps and off-ramps in the area will remain open.

Motorists should expect delays during these closures and give themselves extra time to reach their destinations.
